

Privacy Policy

Effective Date: June 22, 2026

This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) explains how **GuaVas** (“GuaVas,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) collects, uses, discloses, and protects personal information when you use our website, browser extension, software, or related services collectively referred to as the “Services.”

By using our Services, you agree to the practices described in this Policy. If you do not agree with this Policy, please do not use the Services.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following categories of information:

Account Information:

This may include your email address, login details, subscription status, and other information you provide when creating or managing an account.

Payment Information:

Payments may be processed by third-party payment providers. We do not directly collect or store full credit card numbers, debit card numbers, or banking details.

Usage Information:

We may collect information about how you interact with our Services, including features used, pages visited, actions taken, error logs, and performance data.

Technical Information:

We may collect technical data such as browser type, operating system, device information, IP address, extension version, referring URLs, and general location information based on IP address.

Communications:

If you contact us, we may collect your email address, message content, and any other information you choose to provide.

Cookies and Similar Technologies:

We may use cookies, local storage, or similar technologies to keep users signed in, remember preferences, improve performance, analyze usage, and support security features.

2. How We Use Information

We may use the information we collect to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain the Services

- Create and manage user accounts
- Process payments and manage subscriptions
- Improve features, performance, and user experience
- Respond to support requests and user communications
- Send service-related updates, notices, and security alerts
- Detect, prevent, and respond to fraud, abuse, security risks, or technical issues
- Comply with legal obligations and enforce our terms

3. Browser Extension Data

If you use a GuaVas browser extension, the extension may process information necessary to provide its core features. We only collect or access browser-related data as needed to operate, secure, improve, or support the Services.

We do not use browser extension data for purposes unrelated to the Services unless clearly disclosed and permitted by applicable law.

4. How We Share Information

We do not sell your personal information.

We may share information in the following limited situations:

Service Providers:

We may share information with trusted vendors who help us operate the Services, such as hosting providers, analytics providers, payment processors, customer support tools, security tools, and email providers.

Legal Requirements:

We may disclose information if required by law, regulation, subpoena, court order, government request, or other valid legal process.

Business Transfers:

If GuaVas is involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, or sale of assets, user information may be transferred as part of that transaction.

Protection of Rights and Safety:

We may share information when necessary to protect GuaVas, our users, or others from fraud, abuse, security threats, or harmful activity.

5. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary to provide the Services, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, enforce agreements, and maintain security.

When information is no longer needed, we may delete it, anonymize it, or securely store it as required by law or legitimate business needs.

6. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards to protect personal information. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure, so we cannot guarantee absolute security.

7. Your Privacy Rights

Depending on where you live, you may have certain privacy rights, including the right to:

- Access the personal information we have about you
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request deletion of your personal information
- Request a copy of your personal information
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent
- Object to or restrict certain types of processing
- Opt out of certain uses of personal information, where applicable
